Summary of project (overview of the project idea and requirements)	<p>The idea of project stresses on increasing the awareness and professional knowledge for medical Staff approximately 4000 employees at hospitals and primary health care on Mental Health Gap Action Programme (mhGAP) for three years with estimated cost approximately 100,000 dollars to improve the mental health services to patients. The Department of Mental Health in Gaza faces major challenges in the continuity of providing mental health services to all patients in Gaza Strip. According to WHO ,70%of patients go to Primary health care centers suffer and undiagnosed probably from psychological disorder such as stress, anxiety, fear and others and. So, it is important to train and increase the capacity building for medical staff at psychology field to make psychological support to medical staff, patients and their family especially oncological and renal failure patients at MOH-Gaza Strip.</p>
