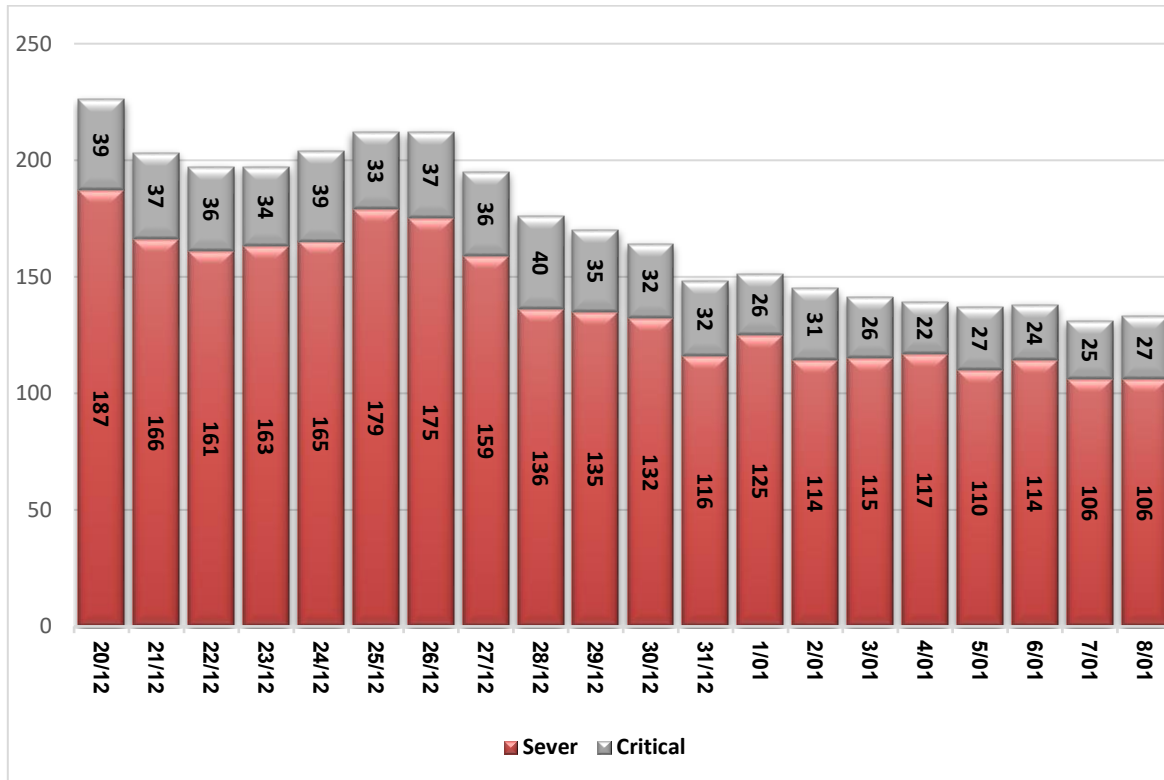

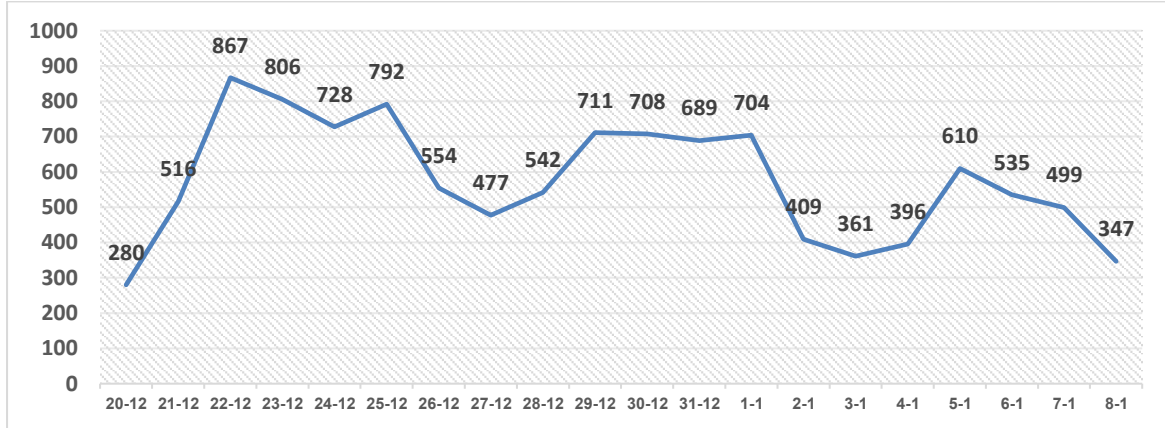
II. Daily classification of active cases according to severity



Graph (1) Shows the daily classification of cases according to degree of severity

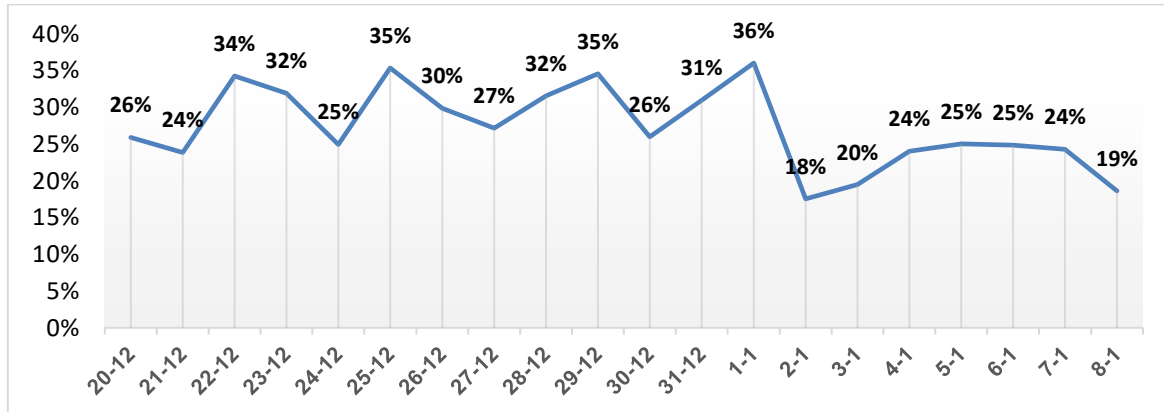


III. Daily number of new cases.

IV. The percentage of positive tests of the daily samples



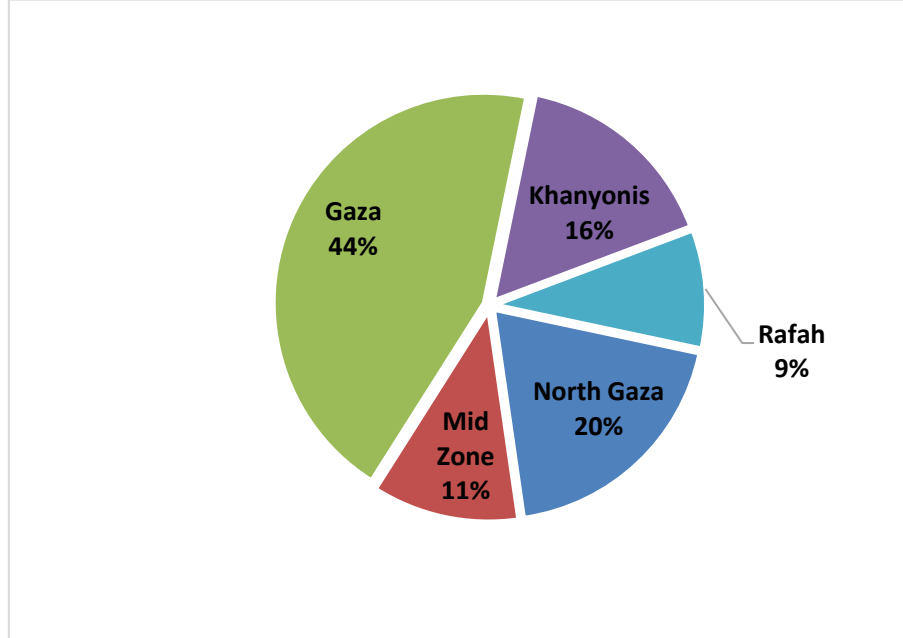
Graph (3) shows percentage of positive tests of the examined samples per day

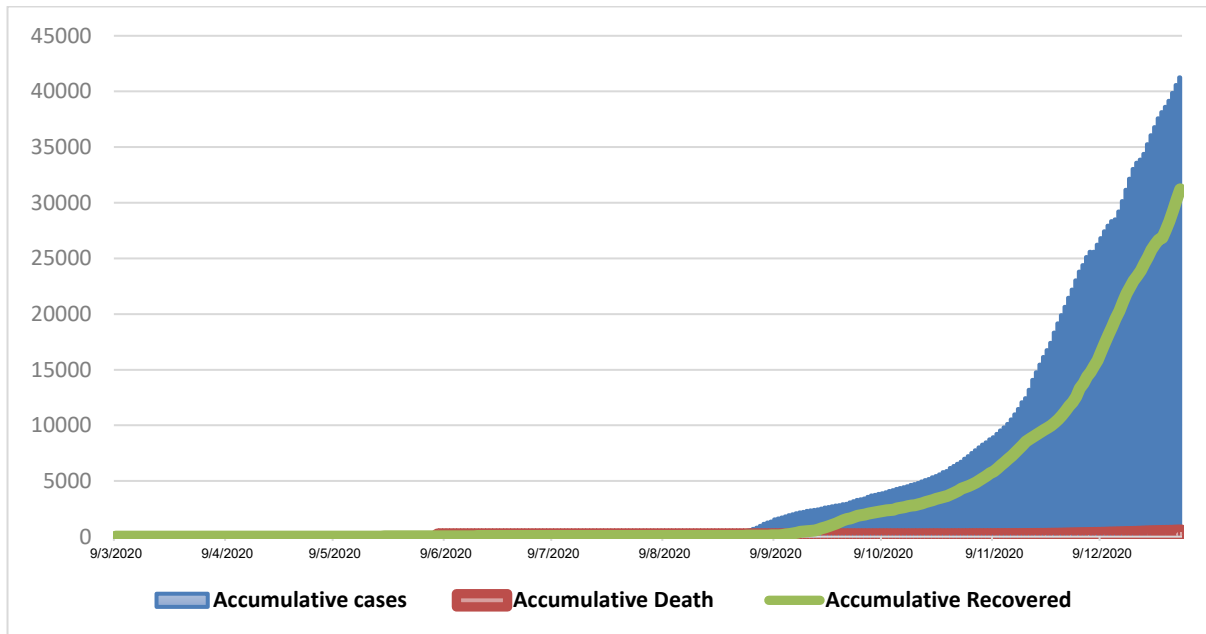


VI. Geographical distribution of confirmed cases.
